# EYEBALL COASTER SET

Paint an eye catching coaster set.



- ### MATERIALS
- Coaster set SKU (C40263)
    - Small round brush
      - Detail brush
        - Tape
        - Pencil
    - Small sponge pouncer
      - French dimensions Really Red
        - Paint 31,67,93,85,27,12

- ### TIPS
- Wash brushes between coats.
  - Allow paint to dry between coats.
  - Use a circle stencil or small round object to help draw the iris. Be sure to make it a bit bigger than the pouncer sponge.
  - Practice making a few squiggles with french dimensions on a piece of aluminum before doing it on the bisque.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Before you begin, wipe a damp sponge over the entire bisque to remove dust and contaminants.

### **Eyeball Coasters**

1. With a pencil draw a circle in the middle of the coaster.
2. Using a small round brush and #93, paint inside of the circle you drew to make the iris. Repeat this step for the other 3 coasters using #85, #27, and #12. (3 coats)
3. Take a small sponge pouncer and #31 to create the pupil in the middle of the iris. (Sponge 3 coats)
4. With a detail brush and #67 make a small dot near the edge of the pupil. (3 coats)
5. Take the french dimensions in "Really Red" and create squiggles for veins starting from the edge of the iris outward.
6. Repeat steps 3 - 5 on remaining coasters.

### **Coaster holder**

Use the tape technique to help make a lined pattern along the sides of the coaster holder.

1. Tape three strips of tape vertically next to one another on one side of the coaster holder.
2. Peel off the middle strip and place it to the right of the third strip.
3. Add a new strip to the right of that one.
4. Once again, peel off the strip before it to create an alternating tape pattern. Repeat this step until you have gone around the whole holder.
5. With a Small round brush and #31 paint between the tape strips. (3 coats)
6. Carefully peel the tape off to reveal pattern.
