

WATERCOLOR FLOWERS: LAVENDER EGG



MATERIALS

C80370 Eggs

Medium Brush

Small Brush

Liner Brush

Pencil or Water-Based

Marker

COLORS

CMM 47 - Deep Sea CMM 92 - Ghostly Grape CMM 29 - Grasshopper



INSTRUCTIONS

This piece can be made with any combination of colors. Below are the instructions for how this exact piece was made, but make it your own to fit your needs!

- 1. Water down some Ghostly Grape paint by mixing 50% water with 50% paint.
- 2. Use a medium brush to apply one coat all over the egg. Move the brush in an x-motion to help achieve the watercolor look.
- 3. Thin down the Grasshopper paint with 50% paint to 50% water.
- 4. Use a liner brush to apply the stems by starting where desired on the side of the egg and pulling down to the base of the egg.
- 5. Then, to apply the grass, start with the liner brush at the base of the egg and flick upward to create the grass.
- 6. Dip the handle of the detail brush into Deep Sea and tap dots along the stems to create the flowers.

TIPS

• By watering the paint down, you'll achieve a more translucent, watercolor effect. Do not worry about 3 coats, we are not going for solid colors.
