# WATERCOLOR FLOWERS: SIMPLE DAISY EGG



## MATERIALS

C80370 Eggs Liner Brush Small Brush Pencil or Water-Based Marker

#### COLORS

CMM 18- Pumpkin Pie CMM 66 - Pink Berry CMM 19 - Banana Boat

#### INSTRUCTIONS

This piece can be made with any combination of colors. Below are the instructions for how this exact piece was made, but make it your own to fit your needs!

- 1. Sketch on the flowers using a pencil or a water-based marker.
- 2. Thin down the Banana Boat, Pink Berry, and Pumpkin Pie with 75% paint to 25% water.
- 3. Use a small brush to apply two coats to the flowers, alternating between the colors.
- 4. To make the centers of the flowers, dip the handle of a small brush into the desired color and stamp it on the center of the daisy.

## TIPS

• By watering the paint down, you'll achieve a more translucent, watercolor effect. Do not worry about 3 coats, we are not going for solid colors.
