## TECHNIQUE: FRENCH DIMENSIONS



### MATERIALS

- Ceramic Plate
- Design to Trace
- Tracing Paper
- Pencil or Pen
- Small Round Brush

Underglazes: Outlines - Black French Dimensions, Fill In Colors - 27, 29, 8, 64, 47 41, 101, 55, 46, 98

### TIPS

- Use a small paper clip or a needle to unclog the tip of the French Dimensions bottle as needed.
- French Dimensions come in multiple colors and can also be used over the painted designs for dimensional accents and decorations.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.** Transfer chosen image onto the bisque using tracing paper or NCR paper and a pen. This technique works best with stained glass type of image where each shape is outlined and all lines in the design are connected.
- 2.** Wipe down your piece with a damp sponge to remove dust.
- 3.** Use Black French Dimensions to outline the design. Imagine that you are decorating a cake. Squeeze the bottle while holding it close to the surface of the piece and slowly follow the outlines from one connection to the next. Stop squeezing and touch the bisque with the tip of the bottle to end each section of the outline.
- 4.** Once the outlines dry, fill in the design elements with the colors of your choice using a small round brush. Don't worry about getting some colors on top of the black outlines. Black raised outlines will come out just fine.
